### **DOUBLING COPPER PRODUCTION AT KANSANSHI**




### The S3 Expansion Project is the future of Kansanshi and is on track for completion in mid-2025

- S3 is the third, and by far the largest, sulphide processing line at Kansanshi. It includes:
  - A copper processing plant designed to treat 25 million tonnes of ore per year (Mtpa)
  - Additional gold concentrator capacity
  - Construction of a new overland conveyor to feed the plant
- Construction is well underway with first ore production expected in mid-2025
- The program at Kansanshi also involves an expansion of the Kansanshi smelter, an expansion of the tailings storage capacity, and the development of the South East Dome, which will become a new pit

### First Quantum is proud to be investing over US\$800M in S3 and related expansion programs at Kansanshi in 2024

- 2024 marks a rapid acceleration in the investment program for Kansanshi's S3 and smelter expansions
- Out of the total c.US\$2bn investment, c.US\$600M has been spent to date, with a further c.US\$1.3bn to be invested by 2029
  - This excludes sustaining capital expenditure, which is expected to account for an additional US\$914M over 2024-2029
- Financing for the expansion has been raised from capital providers globally, with the investment program representing a major inflow of funds into the Zambian economy



# FIRST QUANTUM IS BUYING ZAMBIAN



The creation of a multi-facility economic zone ("MFEZ") in Kalumbila is already producing benefits in localising supply chains

#### **Local Procurement Statistics**

First Quantum spent c.US\$100M per month in 2023 with Zambian-registered suppliers

### **Local Procurement Examples**

- US\$40M mill ball plant commissioned by ME Elecmetal in the Kalumbila MFEZ
  - Simultaneously allows First
     Quantum to reduce its mill
     ball inventory and creates
     valuable jobs in Zambia



- For S3, First Quantum is spending almost \$6M on
   546km of Zambian copper cable from ZAMEFA – that's almost the distance from Solwezi to Lusaka by road
  - This accounts for more than half of the total cable requirement for the project




